Dan Rizzie's multifaceted mixed-media pieces have established him as one of the most successful collage artists of the 20th century. His works most often contain layers of newspaper, paint, wax, and he often incorporates bold botanic imagery: a signature motif is graphic silhouetts of birds or flowers cast in front of abstract patterns. While his artistic sources are vast, Rizzie's compositions are unified and explore traditional imagery in contemporary application.

Dan Rizzie now lives and works in Sag Harbor, New York, but his time here in the 1980's make him a beloved son of Dallas.

Rizzie's collaborative book with Rosanne Cash will be available at the exhibition.
